To improve your chances, apply through:

Company Websites which prevents third-party delays! **Recruitment Agencies** can match you with suitable roles & can speed up the application process.

LinkedIn is a great way to apply! Once you have applied, wait a few days and then message hiring managers to follow up on your application process.

Networking – Attend career fairs, and workshops, this will allow you to meet new people and possibly discover hidden opportunities.

Can ChatGPT write your CV?

Yes ChatGPT can help write the fundamentals of your CV, but when 100 - 1000 are applying for a single job, will this CV help you stand out?

✓ Instead say: "Delivered 50 interactive maths lessons to GCSE students, and successfully helped 4 students pass their exams". This is a more personalised CV point which includes specific, measurable achievements demonstrating your impact and making your CV stand out from other candidates.

Got an Interview? Here's How to Nail It!

To get to the interview stage, your CV passed the test out of 100s or 1000s that applied – Well Done!_____

Keep the interview **conversational**, and be enthusiastic about the job you have applied for.

The interview is a two way street where the interviewer gets to know if you're a good fit for the team but the interview is also an opportunity to find out if you're even interested in the role.

Great Questions to Ask:

- Which software's are essential for the dayto-day operations of the role?
- How has Al impacted your team?
- What do you enjoy about your role?

Once the interviewer answers these questions, keep the conversation going. For example, if the interviewer says this role does involve some Python coding and if you have no experience with Python, instead of saying, "ok", or immediately asking another question, a better response is , "I'm excited to learn Python. While I haven't used it yet, I have experience with X, Y, and Z, which may help." Then ask your next question.
